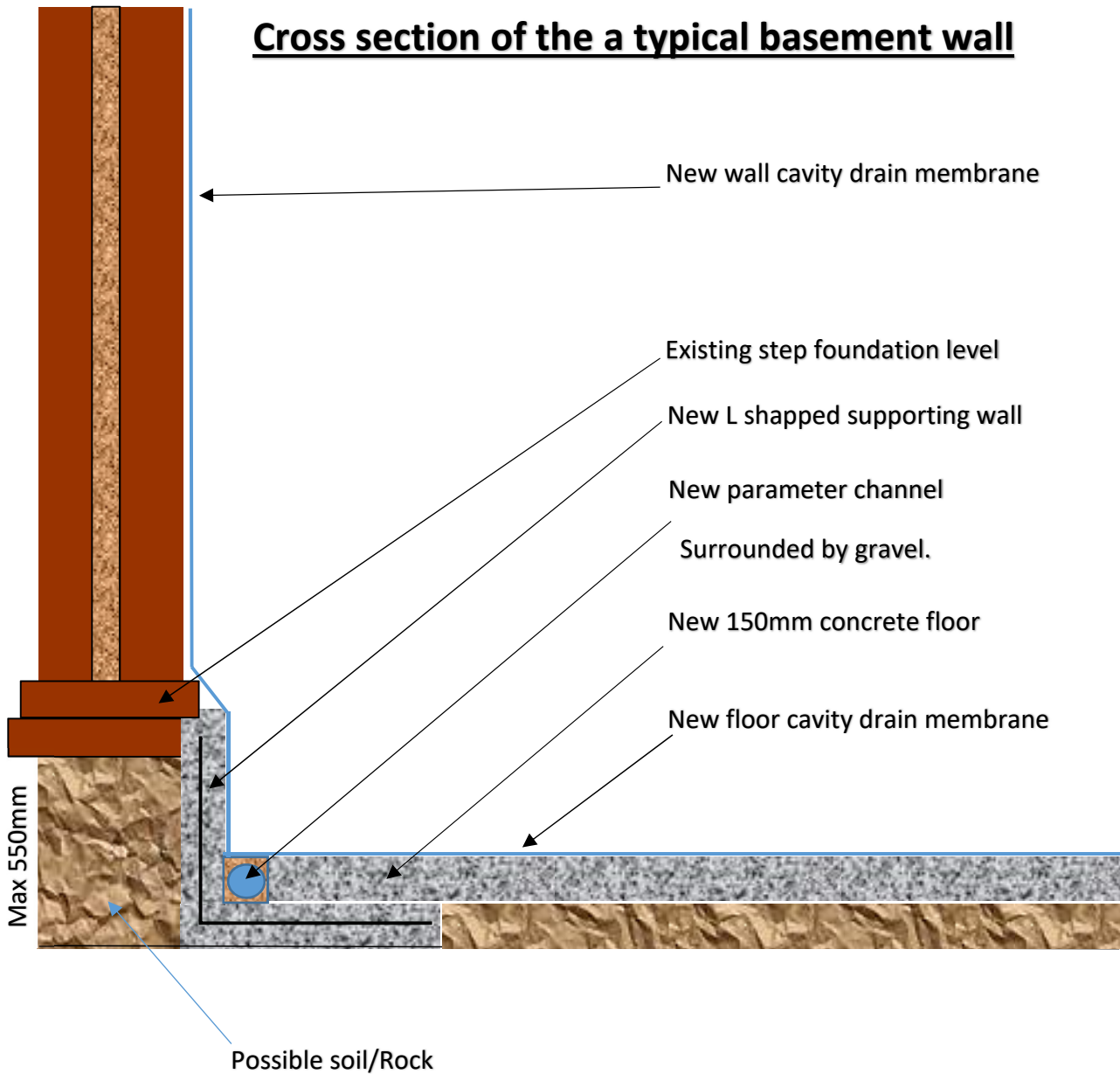


Cross section of the a typical basement wall



THE ABOVE DRAWING IS AN EXAMPLE WHEN THE BASEMENT FLOOR LEVELS NEEDED TO BE REDUCED, HOWEVER NO FOUNDATION CAN BE FOUND AT THE NEW LEVEL.

THIS METHOD CAN BE USED IN MOST CASES WHERE THE LEVELS ARE REDUCED BY 500-600MM.

IF FURTHER REDUCTION IS NEEDED, IT WILL REQUIRE UNDERPINING.
